The Deputy Mayor called the meeting to order and announced that the joint public hearing was called to order. The sole purpose of the meeting is to address any questions or concerns regarding the request by William A. Cavanaugh for annexation of a town parcel into the Village of Wellsville. The property is better known as '1.547 acre vacant parcel located in the Town of Wellsville and which adjoins the Village and better known as Tax Map #230-2-49, being a portion of Great Lot 34, Township No. 2, Range No. 1 of the Morris Reserve'.

The meeting was opened for public comments.

Supervisor Fanton asked for clarification of the location of the subject property. Attorney Synakowski presented a recently completed survey of the property for review by all. There was a question regarding Village services and it was indicated that as soon as the property is annexed it will qualify for all services that are available in that area.

All trustees indicated their consent to the request and it was indicated that the Village Board would pass the necessary resolution later in their regular session, the Town will plan on taking their action at the next Town Board meeting.

There being no further comments the meeting was adjourned at 6:55pm on a motion by Trustee LaForge and second by Trustee Hennessy.
