

Resolution (6-0912) to Change Village Election Date

At a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Wellsville, New York held on September 10, 2012, the following Resolution was approved:

WHEREAS, the Village of Wellsville, after reviewing the advantages of holding future Village Elections concurrent with other elections (and in consideration of the Allegany County Board of Elections conducting Village Elections, and

WHEREAS, those advantages include a more functional transition after elections including time for board training and participation in the annual budgeting process before acceptance, and

WHEREAS, this is provided for under article fifteen of election law as long as the resolution is brought to the electorate in the form of a proposition for vote at a special election and passed more than one hundred and twenty days prior to the next scheduled village election date.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Wellsville does hereby approve changing the date of election from the third Tuesday in March to the month of November per the Allegany County Board of Elections calendar with, by law, current terms extended to that month and pending voter approval at a special election to be scheduled.
